

### Eastern District Promotion/Relegation

The Eastern District teams that are eligible to play-off for the STYSA SCL in the Fall will be ranked based on finish of EDDOA League Play and seed into Cup based on their EDDOA League finish. The Eastern District teams who relegate out of STYSA SCL will be ranked below the Top 2 teams in the Classic bracket after promotion/relegation and seed accordingly into Cup play.

To fill the 7th and 8th seeds for the following year's STYSA SCL Fall season, EDDOA and WDDOA will promote 2 teams each to play off in a round robin tournament two weeks after the completion of the USYSNC state tournament. The top two teams from the EDDOA Classic League will be eligible to participate in the play-off.

The format for the tournament will be a single round robin scored on the 3 point and tiebreaker system outlined in Section 3.5.a and b of the STYSA SCL Rules of Competition. The top two finishers, irrespective of the district the team is from, will be the 7th and 8th seed for the following year's STYSA SCL Fall season. SCL greater than 50% roster eligibility will apply.

At the end of league play, the top two EDDOA Competitive teams will promote to EDDOA Classic Bracket for the following year's EDDOA Fall season and the bottom two EDDOA Classic teams will relegate to the EDDOA Competitive Bracket for the following year's EDDOA Fall season. This final Fall rank after promotion/relegation will seed your team into league play for the following year's EDDOA Fall season. After league play and promotion/relegation the following year's EDDOA Fall season seeding will determine seeding for Spring Cup play (USYSNC, Presidents Cup, and Directors Cup). USYSNC and President's Cup are an open completion, therefore; teams wishing to challenge in USYSNC may do so as per STYSA Spring Cup instructions.

At the end of league play, the top two Super II teams will promote to EDDOA Competitive Bracket for the following year's EDDOA Fall season and the bottom two Division I teams of EDDOA Competitive will relegate to Eastern District Super II for the following year's Eastern District Super II Fall season. This final Fall rank will seed your team into league play for the following year's EDDOA and Eastern District Super II Fall season. After league play and promotion/relegation the following year's Eastern District Super II Fall season seeding will determine seeding for Spring Cup play (USYSNC, Presidents Cup, and Directors Cup). USYSNC and President's Cup are an open completion, therefore; teams wishing to challenge in USYSNC may do so as per STYSA Spring Cup instructions.

At the end of league play, the bottom two EDS2 teams will relegate to Division II for the following year's Fall season and will not be eligible to promote back to EDS2 until after the following year's Eastern District Super II Fall season. Eastern District Fall Championship Division II teams #1 & #2 will promote to Eastern District Super II for the following year's Eastern District Super II Fall season. Any additional openings other than those above will be filled by the EDS2 Committee from applications submitted for the following year's Eastern District Super II Fall season based on Eastern District Standings from previous U14 – U18/19 Fall Season.

Current U14 teams will seed into EDDOA and Eastern District Super II through the U13 Eastern District Qualifying League from the previous Fall season.

To be eligible to return with your seeding, the qualifying team must return greater than 50% of the players rostered from the previous Fall season. For purposes of the STYSA SCL league, EDDOA league, and Eastern District Super II, the following matrix will be used to determine eligibility. SCL teams that qualify and play in PLW may have different eligibility requirements from their respective associations.
